LOCATION: Santa Fe Community Convention Center • 201 W. Marcy St. • Santa Fe, NM 87501

EARLY REGISTRATION & BADGE PICK-UP

Tuesday, August 4 (9:30 – 4pm)

Location: Convention Center in the Peralta Room - accessed by the open door in the courtyard. **DO NOT** enter through any other part of the Convention Center.

BEFORE LOADING IN: You must check-in at the loading dock to pick-up your packets and badges. **DO NOT** temporarily park in the loading dock unless this is your designated load-in spot. **This Is Enforced.**

WE HAVE 3 LOAD-IN LOCATIONS:

Loading Dock: Federal Place between Lincoln Avenue and Grant Avenue entrance (across from the post office)

Loading Zone: Along Grant Avenue alongside the building.

- There will be a security guard to check you in to the loading dock & loading zone.

Garage (119 Federal Pl): Beneath the Convention Center with access to the freight elevator.

SET-UP HOURS:

Wednesday August 5 (9am-5pm). Each Exhibitor will have an assigned Loading Location and time slot. You will be allowed to use loading zone outside of your assigned location and time slot.

You are welcome to legally park outside assigned loading locations, including the garage to load in Wednesday (9am – 5pm) Thursday, August 6 (9am-4pm)

PORTERS: Available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please keep in mind that porters work for tips.

BOX STORAGE: available in the **Lamy Rm** Wednesday with limited access Thursday through Sunday at 5pm. Additional box storage will be available in the **Peralta Rm/Office** Thursday through Sunday 5pm.

EARLY BUYER & BENEFIT PREVIEW: Exhibitors must be in the booth during the times listed below
Thursday August 5 (12pm-4pm) Early Buyer, \$250/person *includes admission to the Benefit Preview & all show days.

Thursday August 6 Benefit Previews, two tiers, *more info below* 5pm – 7pm Silver tier (ticket good through 9pm)
Native American Jump Start, \$175/person: 7pm – 9pm Southwestern Association for Indian Arts \$125 *includes admission to all show days.

SHOW DAYS: Exhibitors must be in the booth during the times listed below

Friday, August 7; Saturday, August 8; Sunday, August 9; (10am – 5pm)

\$18 for a one-day ticket and \$25 for a run-of-show ticket. New Mexico residents' free admission on Sunday Aug.9.

** On show days you may enter the hall at 9:00am (no earlier). **Please don't forget your badge and ID!**

BREAKDOWN: Sunday, August 9 (from 5pm until you leave). During load-out, exhibitors must have items completely boxed and ready for transport before moving vehicle into the load-in area. You will call a crew member when your items are packed and you will be assigned a loading area. **DO NOT PACK UP BEFORE 5PM!**

You must work in your booth to finish by 10pm when our crews must be sent home. Please be respectful that we need to send staff and crew home and **do not leave booth** for extended periods of time before your booth is completely packed up and loaded out.

ALCOHOL: Southwestern Please do not serve alcohol in your booth **it's against the law in New Mexico.** There is a bar located near the Café the length of the show. Alcohol will not be permitted outside the building.

BADGES: length Badges are only allowed for employees of the booth **completely (this will be enforced).**

AMENITIES: Café service by **What the Truck** is available during exhibitor set-up and throughout the show with a variety of food & beverages. *Café seating in available int the O'Keefe Room near café as well as outside in courtyard.* No alcohol will be allowed outside the building.

BAR: A bar will be open during all the show days, Friday through Sunday. Located near the Café' by the fireplace. No alcohol will be allowed outside the building.

PARKING: The underground parking garage is located at 119 S. Federal Place. Open daily from 7am – 10pm. Rates: \$1 for the first hour, \$2 for each hour after that, up to a \$12 maximum.

SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS: If you are shipping items to the venue, please schedule arrivals between Monday August 3 – Wednesday August 5. Please make sure to insure your items. We will receive them and do our best to secure them safely, but we are not responsible for them. Make sure to label your box(es):
